

Rules To Share With Your Guests

River Ridge offers many amenities to its property owners and their guests. To insure everyone a pleasant and safe visit, please share this information with your guests upon their arrival.

- **Guest Registration:** All guests must be pre-registered at the security office prior to their entrance into the Association. Property Owner must be present to have guests, with the exception of immediate family as defined under gate card section in the Blue Rules. **You are at all times responsible for the conduct of your guests.**
- **Boats:** Guests bringing boats into River Ridge must purchase a temporary boat permit from the Security Office. The temporary boat permit must be displayed by placing it around the mirror on the interior of your vehicle.
- **Swimming Pool:** When using the swimming pool, children under 12 years of age must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult. A responsible adult **MUST** be in the baby pool with a child at all times. A complete list of rules is located at the pool.
- **Curfew:** Curfew for all persons 16 and younger is 11:00 PM. (Revised at June 8, 2013 Board meeting)
- **Child Safety:** Please be sure your children know the lot number and village where you are staying so Security will be able to contact a responsible party if your child is lost or injured.

Golf Cart Operation

- Golf cart passengers must be seated and **no standing up on carts** while in motion. Golf carts will be limited to four people or available seating capacity only.
- Golf cart drivers must keep to the right of roadways and **allow vehicles to pass.**
- All minors less than 16 years of age but older than 14 years of age are permitted to drive golf carts provided they have:
 - Completed the golf cart training program -or-
 - Have a learners permit license -or-
 - A valid drivers license
- When driving a golf cart minors (under 18) must have in their possession a copy of their completed golf training certificate or their state learners permit license or valid driver's license.
- Minors under the age of 8 are strictly prohibited from driving a golf cart.
- Any minor between ages 8 thru 14 years old can operate a golf cart as long as they are accompanied by an adult (over the age of 21 years). The adult must be in the front passenger seat and observing the driver at all times.
- Golf carts are required to be equipped with a mounted operational headlight, rear view mirror and a rear light or reflector when operating after dark. **Under no circumstances are flashlights, lanterns, etc. to be used as a headlight.**
